## THE TOWN OF SILVERHILL, ALABAMA

Nestled in the heart of Central Baldwin County, Silverhill is a step back in time to a simpler, easier way of life. Historic buildings and live oaks still line the streets of this quaint town. The bank in town was converted from the People's Supply Store built in 1902, and the Town Library is the first Silverhill School built in 1898.

Steeped in its rich Swedish and Czech heritage, Silverhill has maintained its small-town charm throughout the growth and development both within its town limits and in the surrounding areas. Providing a historic public library, a newly-constructed kids park, a friendly-small town atmosphere, and a commitment to maintaining the quality of life for its residents, Silverhill has ensured that it is, and will continue to be for many years, a "Good Place to Live."



## OVERVIEW OF SILVERHILL SCHOOLS

**Elementary Schools:** Silverhill School has enrollment of 415 students in grades PK – 6<sup>h</sup>. The average attendance rate is 97.2% for grades PK-6. The percentage of students on free or reduced lunches is 48.6%. The faculty makeup of Silverhill Elementary consists of 25 teachers, with 61.8%% holding a Master's Degree- level certification, and 5.9% having a doctorate.

**Middle School:** Students in Silverhill attend Central Baldwin Middle School, which has an enrollment of 632. There are 35 teachers, with 52.1% holding at least a Master's level certification.

**High School:** Silverhill students attend Robertsdale High School, which has an enrollment of 1,190. RHS has 76 teachers, with 47.7% holding a Master's degree, and 5.7% having a doctorate. RHS also offers career / technical training programs whose students have a 97.1% placement rate out of those programs.
